#### CLASS INFORMATION BULLETINS

An information bulletin for families goes home today outlining programs and procedures for the particular level. Please take time to go over the information as it may help with understanding how things will operate in 2017.

#### STUDENT HEALTH ALERTS

We require from families of students with serious health conditions, including anaphylaxis and asthma, a current health plan from your doctor including up to date medications such as epipens, ventolins, etc.

The health of students is always our prime concern and in order to support this we need your child's plan should it be required. With excursions, camps and athletic sports coming up very soon this is absolutely vital. Thank you for your help and cooperation.

#### EVACUATION DRILLS

An evacuation drill will be held this month to evaluate our preparedness for any potential emergency situation. Drills will include both an external evacuation to a safe assembly area and also an internal evacuation or 'lockdown' where buildings are locked to prevent entry. These drills are important to assess how to maximise the safety of everyone at school in an emergency. Students handle these drills with the correct amount of urgency and discuss issues with teachers to better inform them what to do in a potential real emergency situation. If you are at school when the drill is called please cooperate with the controller and help support our practice. Thankyou

## SCHOOL SPORTS VICTORIA NEWS

Each year, talented Victorian School students have the opportunity to trial for a place in the School Sport Victoria (SSV) Team Vic State team. Selected students participate in annual [School Sport Australia](#) (SSA) Championships including the Pacific School Games (PSG) held every second year. These championships offer gifted and talented students the opportunity to participate in higher levels of sporting competition against students from other Australian States and Territories.

Participation in a School Sport Victoria Team Vic state team is self funded. As a guide it may cost between \$2,000-\$3,000 to participate. Costs may include uniforms, host state levies, flights, transport, accommodation and meals. Costs will vary depending on the location of the Championship.

School Sport Victoria enters one representative team in each of the following SSA Australian Rules Championships:
